

Using Gift Aid means that for every £1 you give, we can get an extra 25p from the Inland Revenue.

Example: If you give a gift of £100 we can claim back an additional £25. Therefore this makes your gift actually worth £125, at no extra cost or effort to you.

You only need to fill in one declaration form for the SJHCT (St John's Holidays for Children) and we can claim back the tax you have already paid on every donation you make.

Gift Aid Notes

- 1. Please notify us if you change your name or address.
- 2. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying us.
- 3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each 1 pound you give).
- 4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration.
- 5. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your self assessment tax return.
- 6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
